(3) ECTS-Credits:

(4) Calculation of subject grade:

(5) Calculation of final aggregate grade:
Unless otherwise stipulated in the FSB, the final aggregate grade is reached by the total of individual subject grades according to their ECTS average score (weighted arithmetic mean).
