



ELECTION ANNOUNCEMENT

For the elections to the Senate, the Faculty Boards and the Student Parliament of the Julius-Maximilians-Universität Würzburg

from June 30, 2025, 12 noon to July 4, 2025, 12 noon

In accordance with Art. 48 of the Bavarian Higher Education Innovation Act (BayHIG) in conjunction with Sections 2 et seq. of the Statutes for the Conduct of Elections at Julius-Maximilians-Universität Würzburg (Election Statutes) and the Constitution of the University of Würzburg (GO), the representatives to the Senate (Art. 35 BayHIG), the Faculty Boards (Art. 41 BayHIG) and the Student Parliament (§ 31 GO) will be elected. The term of office of the new representatives to be elected begins on October 1, 2025; it ends for the representatives of the student group on September 30, 2026 and for the representatives of the other groups on September 30, 2027.

I. Committees to be elected

In accordance with Art. 35 and 41 BayHIG in conjunction with §§ 9, 19 and 31 GO, the following representatives are to be elected:

At the same time as the election of student representatives to the faculty boards, the members of the **student councils** are also appointed. The number of members and their appointment is determined by § 34 para. 2 GO. The current number of members of the respective student council is as follows:

A) Faculty of Catholic Theology	7 members
B) Faculty of Law	8 members
C) Faculty of Medicine	9 members
D) Faculty of Arts	11 members
E) Faculty of Human Sciences	11 members
F) Faculty of Biology	7 members
G) Faculty of Chemistry and Pharmacy	7 members
H) Faculty of Mathematics and Computer Science	8 members
I) Faculty of Physics and Astronomy	7 members
J) Faculty of Management and Economics	8 members

The number of students in the faculty at the time the electoral roll is closed is decisive for the number of members of the respective student council.

II. Eligibility to vote and electoral roll

Every member of the university who belongs to the relevant group at the time the electoral roll is closed is entitled to vote and eligible to stand for election. The right to vote and stand for election can only be exercised by eligible voters who are registered in the electoral roll.

The electoral roll will be closed on **June 2, 2025, 4 pm.**

The electoral roll will be available for inspection on May 28, May 30 and June 2, 2025, in each case from 9 am to 4 pm, at the electoral office at the adjacent address. Those affected may lodge a written reminder with the election administrator against non-registration or incorrect registration up to the first working day after the electoral roll closes, i.e. no later than 4 pm on June 3, 2025.

III. Election notification

Every member of the University who is registered in the electoral roll will receive an election notification. Those entitled to vote in the student group receive this via WueStudy; those entitled to vote in the other groups receive this by email to their work email address or by post to their work address. The voting notification shows which group and faculty the member is entitled to vote in, as well as the information required to register in the electronic voting booth (voting portal).

IV. Election nominations

Eligible voters are hereby requested to submit election proposals to the election officer in the period from **April 30 to May 13, 2025, 4 pm.** The nominations **must be in writing** and must be submitted **separately** for each collegial body and for each group. Election proposals that are submitted late **are invalid.**

Only those who are included in a valid nomination can be elected.

The approved election proposals will be announced in the display cases at the east entrance of the New University, opposite Room 104/105, Sanderring 2, by June 16, 2025 at the latest. They can also be viewed on the website of the Electoral Office.

V. Voting

Voting takes place as an electronic ballot in the period from

**Monday, June 30, 2025, 12 noon to
Friday, July 4, 2025, 12 noon**

takes place.

Information on electronic voting and the election portal will be provided in the election notification.

Voting takes place on separate ballot papers for each collegial body. Each voter is entitled to as many votes as the number of representatives to be elected to the relevant body for the group.

Further details can be found in § 11 of the Election Statutes.

VI. Miscellaneous

1. If a deadline is prescribed for the submission of motions or proposals, the deadline ends at 4 pm on the last day.
2. A text of the Election Statutes is posted in the display cases in the corridor at the east entrance of the New University, opposite Room 104/105, Sanderring 2.
